This year's Kansas State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue is being coordinated by Agents in the Northwest Region. Each entry for the State Fair Fashion Revue will need to be entered on the Kansas State Fair 4-H Fair Entry website. As part of the fair entry process, you will be asked to submit the following:

- A. Time block preference for the judging scheduling. Please remind your 4-H members and parents that the time selection is a *request*, and not a guarantee. 8:00, 9:00, 10:00, 11:00 and noon.
- B. Score Card & Cost Per Wear Form

This is the ONLY version of this form that will be accepted. If your local unit uses something different, please do not submit it. This form will be uploaded into FairEntry as a PDF as part of the fair entry process. If 4-H'ers can fill it out electronically the quality is MUCH better. Please avoid scanning on copier and submitting a poor quality, black and white copy.

- C. Public Review Script
 - 4-H members should provide a written script to their Extension Agent so that the office may submit it as part of the fair entry process. Scripts should be 4-6 sentences in length. Write it exactly as you want it read during the public revue. Include 4-H'ers first name and local unit or 4-H club somewhere in the first sentence, the rest of the script should be about the outfit. Some descriptors may include: fabric, colors, patterns, where you will wear the outfit, what you like best, etc. Feel free to include hobbies or a fun fact about yourself in the last sentence only.
- S7.00 participation fee per participating 4-H member
 Please see the <u>Kansas State Fair Fee Schedule</u> for payment instructions.

The FairEntry process must be completed by August 15, or within 5 working days of the completion of the county fair for those counties/districts having fairs after August 10. More information can be found in the fair book, and 4-H exhibitors should read the rules for the 4-H Fashion Revue.

<u>Important:</u> Please inform and remind your Fashion Revue participants that judging takes place the morning of September 13 at the <u>Stringer Fine Arts Building</u> located at Hutchinson Community College, 600 E. 11th Ave, Hutchinson, Ks. There will be two separate public fashion revues, they will both take place in <u>Hansen Auditorium in the 4-H Encampment Building</u> on the Kansas State Fairgrounds the afternoon of September 13.

The Public Revues are scheduled on Saturday, September 13 as follows:
