Depart/Return to US Dates*: July 9-August 6, 2026 **Cost:** \$3,600** + airfare (estimated \$1,600-\$2,000)***

Ages: 12-18

Live with a Japanese host family for the month and experience daily life. You will be placed with a host sibling of similar age to share your experience and learn about Japanese culture. A group camp is offered. No prior Japanese language study is required, but it is certainly helpful.
